Value: up to \$500.

Number:

Variable, awarded up to a maximum of \$5,000 per annum (with \$2500 – Fall, \$2,500– Spring).

Eligibility:

Students enrolled part-time or full-time in any graduate degree program at the University of Lethbridge.

Criteria:

Good academic standing, financial need and a relevant requirement for current research activity or equipment.

Payable:

Payment upon submission of receipt and confirmation of enrolment in graduate studies at the University of Lethbridge in the semester the cost was incurred.

Application:

Submitted by October 15 and April 15.

Students may receive this award once per degree program.

Recipient Selection:

Selection is based on the application and financial need as indicated by application documents. Selection will be determined by the GSA Awards Committee based on deadlines noted above.

Note: The Graduate Students' Association created this bursary in recognition of the financial challenges faced by students to pay for research. This bursary is not meant to replace or supplement funding provided to students in their letter of offer, or for conference travel. This bursary is meant to help offset the ancillary costs of the graduate students' research (expendable research equipment, printing costs, publication fees, etc.) that would not have a reasonable expectation to be paid for by the student's supervisor.
